THE FOUR PARAGRAPH ESSAY

Divide your essay into four paragraphs:

A well rounded essay should consist of four-paragraphs. The *four paragraph essay* contains the following parts:

- 1. **INTRODUCTION PARAGRAPH:** This paragraph states the main idea in the first one or two sentences, proceeds to supporting sentences, and then reinstates the main idea with a conclusion sentence.
- 2. **TWO SUPPORTING PARAGRAPHS:** These paragraphs back up the main idea by providing details for the topic stated in the introduction paragraph. Each supporting statement provides a new piece of information. Supporting sentences can also provide specific examples.
- 3. CONCLUDING PARAGRAPH: This paragraph sums up the essay by reinforcing the ideas given in the introduction and supporting paragraphs in a more general and concise language than supporting paragraphs. A wellwritten conclusion provides the essence of the essay.
